Then the Lexile Tracker will help students start to work toward their career goals. That's the real superpower of the Career Center. It allows students to measure their Lexile growth against the scores required for the career(s) of their choice.

How Does the Career Center Work?

Accessing the Career Center from the Student Edition of Achieve3000 Literacy begins with a student-friendly inventory:

1. Students will complete a career assessment with the results leading to their top RIASEC categories. RIASEC is based on John Holland's six personality types: Realistic (R), Investigative (I), Artistic (A), Social (S), Enterprising (E) and Conventional (C). According to Holland's Theory of Career Choice, choosing work or an education program environment that matches, or is similar to your personality, will most likely lead to success and satisfaction. Their top RIASEC ratings can be filtered out and allow the students to search for careers within that category.

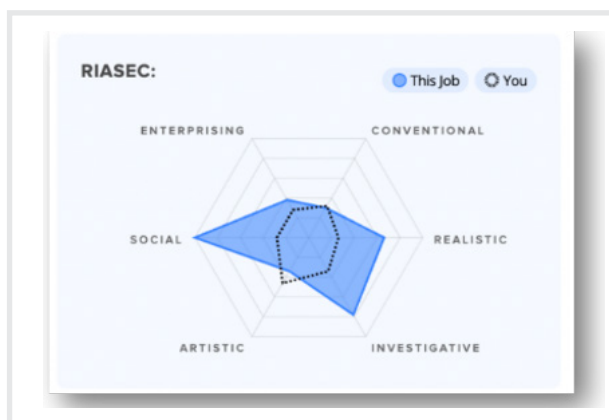

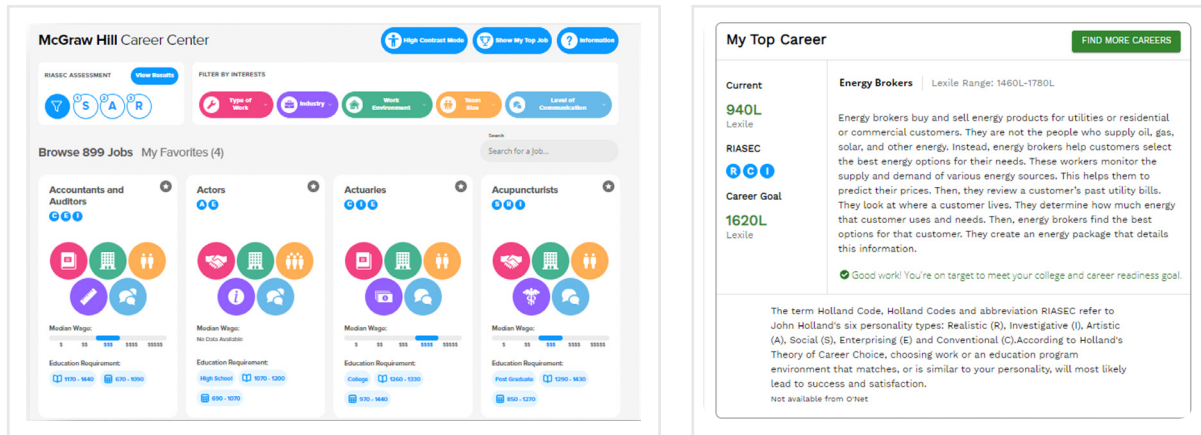

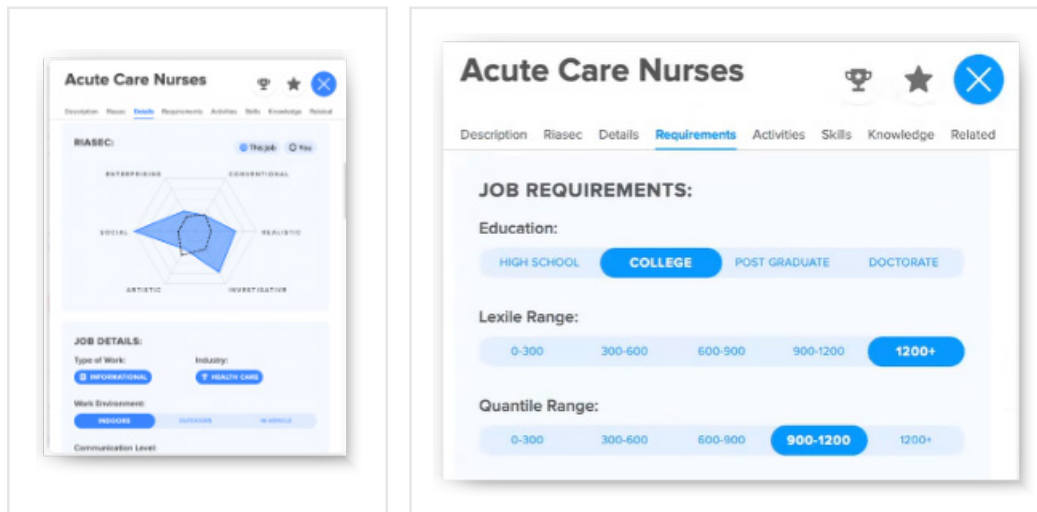
